◆ UOS Scholarship Benefits

1. Full-tuition Scholarship

- UOS will grant this scholarship for 2 years (4 regular semesters).
- The scholarship recipients' GPA should be over B+.

2. Living Allowance: KRW400,000/month

- UOS will grant stipend for 2 years (4 regular semesters).
- The stipend recipients' GPA should be over B+.

3. Full-tuition Scholarship for Korean language courses offered by KLCP

- UOS will grant scholarship for the first regular semesters (20 weeks).

- Student should pay for the tuition for Korean Language Courses after the second semester and on.

b. Recommendation Letter by the President of partner universities

c. One of the following English proficiency test score
