

## **King's College London Summer School: 2 July – 10 August 2012**

The King's College London Summer School is delighted to be opening its doors again in July and August this year. Please find enclosed our new prospectus which details information about the programme and the exciting selection of courses we will be offering students this year.

The Summer School will offer over 60 undergraduate level courses to choose from and in addition to an expanded selection of courses in arts, culture, law, literature, management and politics; we are also delighted to be offering new courses in health & society and physics.

We are very proud of the academic quality and rigour of our courses. Every course has a minimum of 45 contact hours over three weeks and is fully assessed. Each student is awarded an academic transcript upon completion, which many use for transfer of credit back at their home university. All courses are offered at first year undergraduate level, so although students are usually expected to offer at least one year of university study, they do not need a background in any subject so are free to explore different or perhaps new subjects.

This is also a very special year as London prepares for one of the most eventful summers it has seen in many years, hosting the 2012 Olympics. Not only will one of the greatest sporting events take place in London, but also the London 2012 festival will feature exciting cultural events, concerts, exhibitions and educational activities throughout the summer.
